



He/She shall receive and receipt for all monies paid to the club; he/she shall pay bills with~ proper authorization (by the club or its officers constituting a business committee\*). At each meeting, he/she shall submit a statement of disbursements and receipts. He/She shall at the expiration of his/her term, turn over everything in his/her possession belonging to the club to the successor.

The Business Committee shall consist of the President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer.

MEETINGS: ARTICLE 4

The By-Laws shall provide for regular and special meetings. At meetings, the membership in attendance shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

DUES: ARTICLE 5

The club by a majority vote, may levy upon the general membership such dues or assessments as shall be deemed necessary for the business of the organization. The vote may be taken by mail per By-Law No. 5.) Nonpayment of such dues or assessments shall be cause for expulsion from the club at the discretion of the membership, per By-Law No. 4.

MEMBERSHIP ASSISTANCE: ARTICLE 6

This club shall assist when requested in minimizing interference in operation between stations of its members.

AMENDMENTS ARTICLE 7

This Constitution or the By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) votes of the total membership. Proposal for amendments shall be submitted in writing at a regular meeting discussed the next meeting and voted upon at the next (third) meeting after discussion, provided all the members have been notified by mail of the intent to amend the Constitution and/or By-Laws at said meeting.

RULES: ARTICLE 8

Sec. 1 - Robert's Rules shall govern proceedings.

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## BYLAWS

1. SECRETARY-TREASURER. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the Constitution and By-Laws of the club and have the same with him/her at every meeting. He/She shall note all changes and additions and make them available to members upon request.
2. MEMBERSHIP. Membership is open to all persons interested in amateur radio. The right to hold office and to vote for club officers is limited to licensed radio amateurs only. Applications for membership shall be submitted and voted on at a regular meeting. Acceptance is determined by a simple majority vote of those present.
3. MEETINGS. Regular meetings shall be held monthly at such a time, place and date as the president orders. Special meetings may be called by the president. Notice shall be sent to members concerning SPECIAL meetings and the business to be transacted. Notices shall be sent so as to arrive not less than twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting time.
4. DUES. The annual dues, determined by the club are payable on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of the Constitution. They will be considered delinquent after 90 days of non-payment. At this time the member is AUTOMATICALLY EXPELLED from the club. A member may be reinstated upon payment of all unpaid dues and the balance due for the full year. Any member reapplying after more than one year (12 months) must be voted on for membership. Dues are 100% for the first member of a household and 50% for all others.
5. MAIL VOTING. A vote mailing will require ten (10) days minimum advance notice. A vote not returned will be considered a vote "for" the subject being voted upon. The mail or absentee ballot will be maintained for public inspection and will be opened in the presence of the club.
6. RATIFICATION. This CONSTITUTION becomes effective by a two-thirds vote of the membership.
7. NEWSLETTER. Should a newsletter be published, only one copy will be provided per household.
